When purchasing dental equipment, particularly online, the person responsible should be aware of the risks of counterfeit and non-compliant instruments and devices and exercise common sense and care. There should be systems in place to ensure that equipment is genuine, compliant and safe to use.

The Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency and the British Dental Industry Association strongly recommend that all purchases, however small, are made from a reputable supplier.
